
# Phygital Phonics Walkshop with Freemetre. Sunday 12th November. 1pm.

#### **Remnant Walk**

The walk transitions from an everyday urban environment into a discreet rewilded space – a remnant shaped by constructed borders, town planning, and natural growth.



### **Meeting Point**

Meet on Sunday 12th November in the car park of The National Pub, leaving at 1pm. Please note the car park is for patrons only, but there is plenty of on street parking in the area. The National Pub, 19 National Ave, Hull HU5 4HP.

## **Description**

Beginning in a suburban area, the roadside route turns onto a waymarked track alongside a drainage dyke. The path then leads through a densely wooded area until reaching a pedestrian railway bridge. The walk then loops back through a tree-lined grassed pathway, before heading back along the dyke.

**Terrain** Flat, unpaved, muddy in places. **Distance** 2 miles **Duration** Up to 2 hours, allowing for creative exploration.
